2026-2027 Enrollment Fee and Tuition

Notes About the Enrollment Fee:

- The enrollment fee will be charged to the account you have on file in TADS on **Monday, January 12, 2026**
 - Contact the school office if you need to make arrangements for this fee or if you have questions about enrollment for the 2026-2027 school year.
- Non-refundable enrollment fee for kindergarten – 8th grade to reserve and hold a spot:
 - \$300 per student/\$600 per family
 - February 15 or later - \$350 per student/\$700 per family
- The enrollment fee is used to pay for core needs of the classroom, such as:
 - Curriculum
 - Student Activity Accounts (supplies and field trips)

Financial Aid:

Cost of Education at St. John's:

- Tuition charges are reviewed annually, based upon the per pupil cost.
- Every child that attends St. John's is blessed by the generosity of our congregation members. Tuition does not cover the full cost of educating the child. The church subsidizes a portion of the overall school budget, covers the costs of the building and maintenance, along with providing financial aid.
- St. John's church members are asked to continue their support through church contributions.

St. John's Lutheran School reserves the right to refuse enrollment to any student who is beyond the scope of our educational resources, or in any instance where enrollment would not be in the best interest of the enrolling child or the children of St. John's Lutheran School.
